Love Serves: A Woman Named Tabitha

Peter was in a town called Lydda at the same time a disciple named Tabitha was nine miles away in Joppa. Tabitha became very sick and died. In Acts, Luke says Tabitha "was full of good works and acts of charity" (Acts 9:36). When she died, they washed her and laid her in an upper room. They sent two men to Lydda because they heard that Peter was there. When Peter came to the house where Tabitha lay, "all the widows stood beside him weeping and showing tunics and other garments that Dorcas (Tabitha) made while she was with them" (Acts 9:39).

Several things stand out with this story. First, Peter went immediately when the men came for him. We don't know if he intended to raise her from the dead initially, but he certainly was going to be with the grieving widows. It's also important that the widows were showing Peter the tunics and other garments that Tabitha made for them. She had a ministry where she provided clothing to this group of widows, and it meant the world to them. And after Peter raised Tabitha, he stayed in Joppa for "many days." It was while Peter was in Joppa that both Cornelius and Peter had a vision that would completely change Peter's ministry. Tabitha's service to the widows had ripple effects that spread very far and wide. We should be servants like Tabitha!--Jimmy Hinton
