Not Knowing Which Seeds Prosper

Ecclesiastes is traditionally recognized as a book written by Solomon. It includes the good and the bad, and everything in between. Solomon tried everything under the sun and describes them as "vanity"--a Hebrew word that often refers to a mist or vapor. Everything is temporary and vanishes quickly. But he goes on to say that, just as we don't know how the spirit comes into the bones of a woman who is pregnant, neither do we "know the work of God who makes everything" (Ecclesiastes 11:5).

Solomon says, "In the morning sow your seed, and at evening withhold not your hand, for you do not know which will prosper, this or that, or whether both alike will be good (Eccl. 11:6). I think a more modern interpretation would be, "You don't have control of what God blesses, so stop trying to pretend that you do!" The thought of control is just an illusion. God is the one who blesses, and that's good news for us! All we have to do is sow. We leave the rest up to God. God may bless one seed. Or he may bless all of them. We don't know. So we shouldn't spend our time watching the seeds and coaxing them to sprout. We should sow our seed in good faith and hold our hand out in the evening. God has always blessed. He has always provided. He has always turned a remnant into a major blessing. And this is good news!--Jimmy Hinton
