The Steadfast Love of the Lord

Psalm 118 talks about the steadfast love of the Lord enduring forever. God's love is enduring. He lavishes compassion on the weary. When we are in distress he answers: "Out of my distress I called on the Lord: the Lord answered me and set me free" (Psalm 118:5). "It is better to take refuge in the Lord than to trust in man. It is better to take refuge in the Lord than to trust in princes" (vs. 8-9). God's steadfast love is reserved for the righteous. "Open to me the gates of righteousness, that I may enter through them and give thanks to the Lord. This is the gate of the Lord; the righteous shall enter through it" (vs. 19-20).

Over and over the Psalms talk about God being the refuge and our salvation. Oftentimes we confuse God with people. We should not demand that people come to us, but should encourage them to turn to the Lord. His love is steadfast. It is enduring. It cannot be shaken. God loves and protects the weary. He waits for them so that he can offer shelter. God's steadfast love is linked to salvation and righteousness. So much so, that Jesus quotes from Psalm 118:22: "The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone." Jesus is our steadfast love and salvation. When we realize this we can "give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; for his steadfast love endures forever!" (Ps. 118:29)--Jimmy Hinton
