Words of the Wise are Like Goads

A goad was a slender stick that was pointed on one end and flat on the other, used to guide cattle and keep them on the right path. Paul "kicked against the goads," a common phrase at the time which meant that someone was resisting direction or guidance. In Ecclesiastes, it concludes "The words of the wise are like goads, and like nails firmly fixed are the collected sayings; they are given by one Shepherd" (Ecclesiastes 12:11).

We cannot underestimate the significance of wisdom, especially consistency in wisdom! It's one thing to search for wisdom. It's quite another to use caution with all of our words. Words are important. They convey vital messages. Jesus is described as the Word. God spoke the world into existence. James says that the tongue is as powerful as the rudder of a ship--though small, it can steer an entire ship. Words are so, so important. And when we exercise wisdom, those words are like goads. They keep people on track. Jesus often said, "He who has ears, let him hear." We need to listen to wisdom and let it be our instructor and guide. The alternative is not very healthy.--Jimmy Hinton
